The Fall NSF I/UCRC Meeting will be held October 28-29, 2009 in Storrs, Connecticut on the campus of the University of Connecticut. The University of Connecticut has a hotel on campus, the Nathan Hale Inn <http://www.nathanhaleinn.com/> (860) 427-7888 that can accommodate visitors. In addition, there is a Best Western Regent Inn in Mansfield Center, CT, that is approximately 4-5 miles off campus that visitors may also utilize. Kerrie Alberts, our contact at UCONN kerrie@engr.uconn.edu has blocked off a set of rooms at the Nathan Hale Inn for the nights of 10/27 and 10/28.
