Dr. Mansi Kasliwal is an Assistant Professor of Astronomy at the California Institute of Technology, Pasadena, CA. She is an internally recognized scientist with numerous publications in peer reviewed journals. Her areas of research include time domain astronomy, seeking electromagnetic counterparts for gravitational waves, transient clusters. She has observing experience on both space-based and ground-based observatories. She has received prestigious professional awards, including a Hubble Fellowship, and received recognition from the American Astronomical Society as a keynote speaker at its 231st meeting in January 2018.
