

## Conference Highlighting Student Research on COVID19 Pandemic

A team led by Professor Yulia Gel at UT Dallas has organized an [NSF student conference on COVID19 modeling](#) to be held on January 28-29, 2021. The conference aims to highlight a broad range of interdisciplinary developments on understanding mechanisms behind COVID19 dynamics and to span such research areas as mathematical biology, statistics, epidemiology, and data science. The conference will include contributed talks from undergraduate and graduate students and postdocs, plenary addresses from senior researchers, discussion forums with senior colleagues, and an invited panel on career development and opportunities such as NSF Graduate Research Fellowships, internships, graduate admission, and early career funding, particularly in light of the COVID19 pandemic.

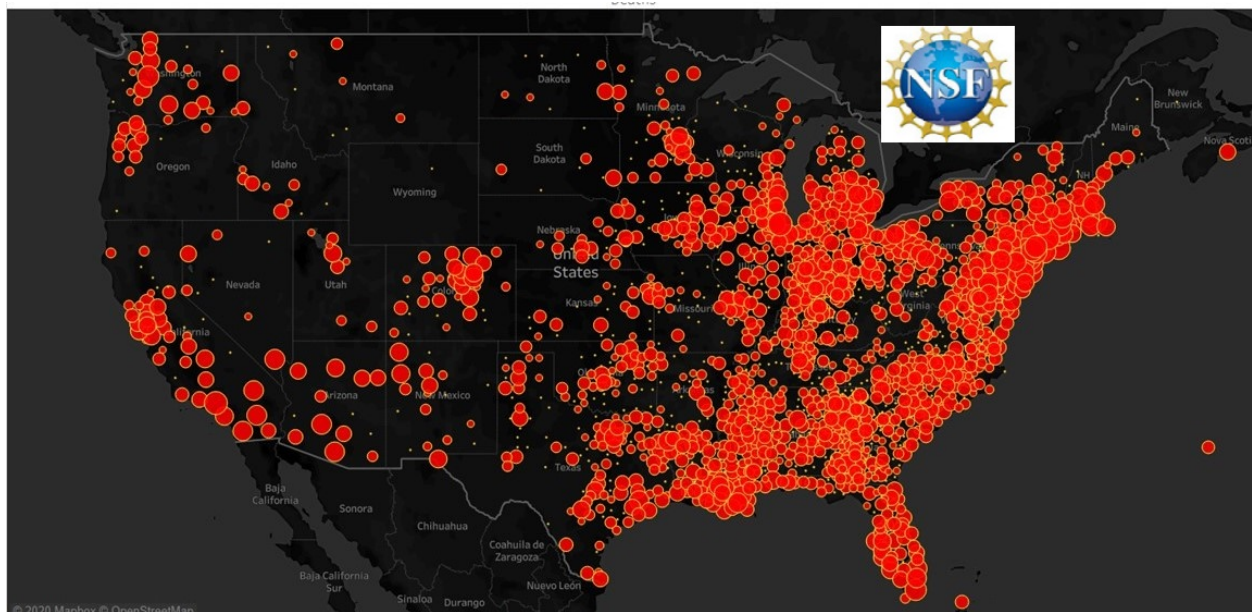
