The <u>Southeast Center for Mathematics and Biology (SCMB)</u> will host its <u>3rd Annual Symposium</u> as a free online event from December 7-10, from 12:00pm-2:00pm (EST). The Symposium will explore the theme of *Interactional Expertise*—an idea behind many successful cross-disciplinary collaborations. The event will feature panel discussions with math-bio researchers and explore the successes and the pitfalls of collaborating across disciplines. Junior speakers from all four NSF-Simons MathBioSys research centers will contribute talks demonstrating the innovative work being done at the math-bio interface. The Symposium will conclude with a plenary talk from Heather Harrington (Oxford) on *Algebraic Systems Biology* and a poster session.
