

NSF FY 2019 BUDGET REQUEST AS OF FEB 7TH

 NSF's request was set to be released at \$5.27 billion, a 30 percent, or \$2.2 billion decrease from FY 2017

Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018



WHITE HOUSE RESPONSE

- Administration pivot on FY 2019 budget levels
- Provided additional funding to select number of agencies for the FY 2019 Request
- NSF received an additional \$2.2 billion, increasing total FY 2019 Request to \$7.47 billion, flat to FY 2017

NSF FY 2019 BUDGET REQUEST AS OF FEB 12TH

- President delivered budget to Congress at previous level, with Addendum showing the additional funds
- Account levels showing a total of \$7.47 billion
