### FY 2021 BUDGET

- NSF's FY 2021 Appropriation is \$8.5 billion
  - \$208 million over the FY 2020 Current Plan (\$8.3 billion)
  - \$745 million over the FY 2021 Request (\$7.7 billion)

### FY 2021 CONGRESSIONAL GUIDANCE

- Continued support for industries of tomorrow, including focused outreach to HBCUs, HSIs, Tribal Colleges and Universities, and other Minority-Serving Institutions.
- EHR is +3.1% above FY 2020 Plan. Congress identified specific priorities and levels for 75% of the total provided.
- Continued support for MREFC and mid-scale research infrastructure.



## Budget Year Update – FY 2022





NSF FY 2022 TOTAL:

\$10.169 BILLION • Advances research benefits through fundamental R&D.

• Promotes STEM talent and furthers accessibility and inclusivity.

• Strengthens U.S. leadership in emerging technologies.

• Supports NSF institutional needs.



#### **ADVANCING RESEARCH & RESEARCH BENEFITS**

The FY 2022 Discretionary Request includes the following:

- Increases total investment for climate and clean energy related research to <u>\$1.2 billion</u>.
- Provides an additional <u>+\$100 million</u>, or roughly +<u>50%, for racial equity</u> in science and engineering.
- Adds to R&D investments to implement NSF strategic priorities across the agency.
- In total, provides <u>+\$1.5 billion</u> for NSF R&D.
