

Rural residents and their contexts vary greatly based on their location, geographic and community assets, and local economies

- Reframe the deficit narrative of rural people and places
- Over 9.3 Million students attend a rural schools<sup>1</sup> (1 in 5)
- Culturally, racially, and ethnically diverse (1 in 4)
- Recognize both the assets and unique challenges
- Shifts in rural employment

## Challenges for Rural Schools and Communities

 Often lack state-of-the-art technological tools, resources, and affordable broadband connectivity

Face challenges preparing, recruiting, and retaining STEM teachers

- 3. Rural schools do not receive adequate funding
- Climate and extreme weather disproportionally impact rural communities





Leverage strong relationships, commitment to place, and multi-generational connections to the school as community center

- Reinforce authentic and place-based connections involving equity and culturally responsive practice
- 2. Support innovative recruitment and retention strategies and targeted professional learning
- 3. Support STEM education co-engagement, collaborative partnerships
- 4. Target funding to enhance higher education access for rural learners
- 5. Fund increased state-of-the-art technological tools
