Isaac Natter is an Associate Counsel in the Department of the Navy (DON) Acquisition Integrity Office (AIO), an office of the DON Office of the General Counsel (OGC). Isaac joined the DON AIO in April 2010. The DON AIO is led by the Associate General Counsel (Acquisition Integrity), the DON's Suspension and Debarment Official (SDO), who has authority from the Secretary of the Navy to suspend and debar contractors from government contracting. The DON AIO is also responsible for advising the General Counsel and the Secretary of the Navy on all significant acquisition fraud issues and manages, directs, and coordinates all acquisition integrity related matters to assure that the DON deters, detects, and eliminates procurement fraud, takes action against those who commit procurement fraud, protects the DON from future procurement fraud, and recovers amounts due the DON because of fraud. The DON AIO also develops and oversees procurement fraud policies, practices, and training. At the DON AIO, Isaac reviews contracting and procurement fraud allegations and cases and makes recommendations for suspension or debarment to the DON SDO. His role includes coordinating with investigative agents, command counsel, other agencies, and the Department of Justice to ensure adequate investigative development and the Navy's cooperation with and support of fraud investigations.

From October 2012 through September 2013, Isaac was the DON OGC Harvey J. Wilcox Fellow. As the Wilcox Fellow, Isaac was able to develop a firsthand understanding of OGC's operations, the provision of legal services to the Secretariat, and the development of legal policy for the DON. Isaac closely observed and supported the General Counsel, Principal Deputy General Counsel, Deputy General Counsel, Assistant General Counsels, and Command Counsels, and served with various legal offices throughout the DON OGC on a series of six-week rotations.

Before joining the DON AIO, Isaac was an Assistant Counsel, Naval District Washington (NDW), one of the regions under the Commander, Naval Installation Command (CNIC). In that capacity, he primarily practiced civilian personnel law, advising NDW on labor and employment issues, and litigating on behalf of the DON in administrative forums and federal courts (working with the Department of Justice as agency counsel). Additionally, Isaac provided legal advice and guidance to NDW on a spectrum of legal topics, including contracting, fiscal law, environmental law, real estate, and ethics.

Isaac joined the DON OGC in September, 2006. Prior to the Navy, Isaac worked as an attorney in the insurance defense, disability, and workers' compensation fields in Louisiana and Washington, DC. Isaac is a member of the Louisiana and Washington, DC state bars. He graduated from Tulane Law School in 2004, and Oberlin College, with a degree in Neuroscience, in 2001. Isaac grew up in the Washington, DC area, where he currently lives with his wife Danielle, daughter Sienna, son Dexter, a Great Dane, and too many cats.
