Richard Sponseller is a civil Assistant United States Attorney (AUSA) and Senior Litigation Counsel (SLC) in the Eastern District of Virginia, Alexandria, Virginia. He has worked as a criminal prosecutor and civil litigation attorney for over 30 years in state and federal courts. As Assistant District Attorney and Deputy Attorney General in Pennsylvania, he prosecuted homicides, violent crime, white collar fraud, drug crime, and RICO cases. He was an AUSA in the Middle District of Pennsylvania beginning in February 1989. From May 1991, until February 1995, he was Deputy Director of the Programs Branch for the Department of Justice's Executive Office for United States Attorneys (EOUSA). He oversaw efforts by United States Attorneys to prosecute civil actions under the False Claims Act and through asset forfeiture laws. He began as an AUSA and SLC in the Eastern District of Virginia in February, 1995.
