^b In 2011, the survey required institutions to begin reporting information on more than one race, along with information in the other racial and ethnic categories, but institutions were not required to update the race and ethnicity data of individuals who were already in the system. Therefore, the number reported for more than one race for the early years following 2011 is likely to be an undercount.

NOTES: Institutions awarding the same number of degrees are listed alphabetically. Data are based on degree-granting institutions eligible to participate in Title IV federal financial aid programs and do not match previously published data that were based on accredited higher education institutions. Race or ethnicity breakouts are for U.S. citizens and permanent residents only. Starting with 2011, data reflects the Office of Management and Budget's latest race and ethnicity categories. Therefore, this table differs from previous years in that it aggregates data for the most recent 4 years instead of 5 and the numbers for the new categories may be an undercount given that institutions did not have to re-enter data for students already in the system.
